6.7 Sun Cream Policy

Policy statement

Treetops needs to ensure that all children are protected from the effects of the sun and we have procedures in place to do this.

We will:

- Inform parents/carers that they need to put sun cream on their children before bringing them to pre-school.
- Obtain written permission from parents/carers to apply sun cream to their children and to say they have no allergies to it.
- Monitor children's time in the sun and on exceptionally hot/sunny days limit their exposure to the sun, especially in the hottest part of the day (11 am – 3 pm).
- Provide shade in the garden where possible
- Advise parents/carers who do not want to apply cream to their children that they should provide a long sleeve top and a hat with face and neck protection and obtain their written request not to apply sun cream to their child.
